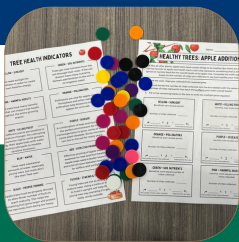


- Part of a nation-wide program whose mission is to increase ag literacy through K-12 education
